ON DUS CONVICTIONS:

(a) TO GET DRIVING PRIVILEGES, MUST HAVE RESTRICTED PLATES/IMMOBILIZATION/IMPOUND PLATES

(b) IMMOBILIZATION & IMPOUNDING PLATES & RESTRICTED PLATES

1st Offense: DUS 4510.11; DUS-OVI 4510.14

2nd Offense: DUS 4510.11; DUS-FRA or DOF 4510.16; DUS-OVI 4510.14

(c) DRUG SUSPENSIONS MUST HAVE RESTRICTED PLATES
